**Scholarship Eligibility and Application Requirements**  
*\*\*For Georgia Students Currently Enrolled at Alcorn State University\*\**

**Eligibility Requirements**

- Resident of the State of Georgia.
- Currently enrolled at Alcorn State University (ASU) as a full-time undergraduate student in good standing.
- Minimum 2.50 grade point average (on a 4.0 grading scale).
- If selected for a scholarship, verification of full-time enrollment for Fall 2026 at ASU must be submitted to the Metro-Atlanta Alcorn Alumni Chapter (MAAC) Scholarship Committee. Students who have previously won a MAAC scholarship are ineligible to apply for another scholarship.

**Application Requirements**

- A Gmail email is required to complete the application. If you do not have one, you must create one.
- Go to <https://forms.gle/1UAcdALdZNezAbLC7> to complete your online application and upload the following required supporting documents:
  - *Proof of current full-time enrollment on Alcorn letterhead from Alcorn Admissions or Registrar OR a printout from your Alcorn Banner Student Account with your class schedule **and** registration status.*
  - *Transcript or copy of all grades from your Alcorn Banner Student Account.*
  - *Color photo of yourself with plain background (no group photo).*
  - *Essay (**submitted as a pdf file**) – double-spaced, minimum 500 words discussing the following:*
    - *Who has been the most influential person(s) in your life and why?*
    - *How do you feel your experiences at ASU are preparing you for the next chapter of your life?*
    - *What are your plans after graduation from ASU?*
    - *If applicable, explain any extenuating circumstances that may have affected you and your family financially and/or affected your grades.*

**Your essay responses must be written in your own words.**

- *Two letters of recommendation (**submitted as pdf files**).*
  - *One academic recommendation letter on official ASU letterhead from a professor, dean, or advisor.*
  - *One character, community service, or employer recommendation letter from chair, employer, club advisor, etc.*
- Your full name should be clearly visible on all documents submitted.

**Application Deadline**

Online application and supporting documents must be submitted by **May 16, 2026**, to be considered for a scholarship. Incomplete packages will not be considered.
